

"EXPLORY TALENT CAMP" YOUTH CAMP

Idea:

Organization of the camp together with the Polish Center for International Aid for talented young people from Ukraine aged 15 to 19, who crossed the border after February 24th, 2022 due to the war and are still staying in the area of Poland, combined with recreation and active rest by the water (Integration by Workation model).

Camp location:

The city of Iława in the Warmian-Masurian Voivodeship (Western Masuria), located near Lake Jeziorak, the longest in Poland (27.5 km) - a large Ukrainian minority, excellent communication (direct railway connections to most voivodeship cities).

Date:

Second half of August: August 19th-25th, 2022

Cost:

The camp is free of charge. Participants bear only the cost of travel to and from Iława.

Recruitment:

Number of participants:

100 people with a preference for people communicating in English (substantive classes in English).

Substantive programme:

- working with the use of the project method on selected UN Sustainable Development Goals;
- Hackathon No-Code - creating mobile applications using No-Code / Low-Code tools.

Accompanying programme:

- sports activities on the water (canoeing, rowing track, islands on Jeziorak);
- integration activities;
- all-day trip to the Tri-City (visiting Gdańsk).

Benefits:

- know-how in the field of no-code programming, using artificial intelligence;
- learning about the Sustainable Development Goals presented by specialists;
- making friends with young people with similar interests, recreation and intercultural exchange.

Camp plan:

Day 1 - arrival (the camp begins with dinner, organizational meeting and integration).

Day 2 - Sustainable Development Goals, Hackathon as well as sports and integration activities.

Day 3 - Sustainable Development Goals, Hackathon as well as sports and integration activities.

Day 4 - all-day trip to the Tri-City (tour around the city, lunch and attractions).

Day 5 - Sustainable Development Goals, Hackathon as well as sports and integration activities.

Day 6 - Sustainable Development Goals, Hackathon and a substantive location-based game.

Day 7 - departure (participants leave the camp after breakfast).
